Notes for THOMAS DUNGAN:

IMMIGRANT ANCESTOR.

Thomas was a representative to the Rhode Island Assembly, sergeant on the Newport militia, and one of the patentees of East Greenwich, RI. He sold his real estate and moved in 1682 to Cold Spring, Fall Township, Bucks Co., PA and established the first Baptist church in Pennsylvania.

and being of sound and perfect mind and memory do
make and publish this my last will and testament In
manner and form following hereby revoking all former
will or will by me made and this only to be taken as my
last will and testament. First I desire that i may be buried
in a decent and Christian manner at the direction
of my Executor and that all my lawful debts and
funeral expenses be first paid Secondly I desire that
all and every my Estate both real and personal be
sold by public vendue my wearing apparel only except
and the sale to be made within two years after my
decease as my Executor may think more advantageous
Thirdly I will and desire that there be made an equal
division of all and every of the arrangement-of the sale
of my estate and the interest of each and every ones pro
portion to be paid them from the day of sale till they receive
their proportion paid Namely James Radcliffe Phebe
Cadwallader Johnathan Radcliffe Isaiah Radcliffe Rebeca
Hough Rachel Nelans and Joseph Radcliffe and I
desire that my wearing apparel may be equally divided
as my Executors sees more equal among my four sons
above mentioned and lastly I appoint my two sons
namely James Radcliffe and Jonathan Radcliffe Executors
in witness where of I have here unto set my hand and seal
this twelfth day of January one thousand seven hundred
and eighty eight.

Notes for ISAIAH RADCLIFFE:

In Ellis' 1882 History of Fayette County History of Redstone township page 724 Isaiah Ratcliffe, a Quaker, was one of Redstone's pioneer blacksmiths. He setup his shop near Dunlap's Creek Church, but did not tarry long. he died before 1800.He had made the journey from the east with Alexander Nelan, who made his settlement in Luzerne on the river. A son of Isaiah Ratcliffe now lives in Brownsville in his eighty-sixth year. Isaiah's wife, Hannah, left a will in 1836. Isaiah is named in his father's will in Bucks Co., Pennsylvania.

In the name of God Amen, know all persons by these presents that I, Hannah Radcliff being weak in body but of sound mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following principally and first of all I commend my soul unto God who gave it {and my soul unto God who gave it} and my body to the earth to be buried in a decentand Christian like manner. And as it respects my worldly concerns, First I will and bequeath unto my son Joseph all my real estate. 2nd I will and bequeath unto my son John my copper kettle, 3rd I will and bequeath unto my son Laban one dollar, 4th I will and bequeath all my personal property to my three daughters viz. Rebecca, Sarah, Feby (Pheobe) to be divided equally against them, 5th I will and bequeath unto my son Samuel one dollar. Lastly, I constitute, make, and ordain my son Joseph executor of this my last will in witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this 19th day

of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.
