In the name of God Amen, know all persons by these presents that I, Hannah Radcliff being weak in body but of sound mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following principally and first of all I commend my soul unto God who gave it {and my soul unto God who gave it} and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner. And as it respects my worldly concerns, First I will and bequeath unto my son Joseph all my real estate. 2nd I will and bequeath unto my son John my copper kettle, 3rd I will and bequeath unto my son Laban one dollar, 4th I will and bequeath all my personal property to my three daughters viz. Rebecca, Sarah, Feby (Pheobe) to be divided equally against them, 5th I will and bequeath unto my son Samuel one dollar. Lastly, I constitute, make, and ordain my son Joseph executor of this my last will in witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal this 19th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.

Be it remember that on the ninth day of September A. D. 1836 personally appeared before Robert Barton,

Patterson and John Goucher the subscribing witnesses to the foregoing last will and testament of Hannah Radcliff late of Washington Township, Fayette County, deceased, and on these oaths did respectfully declared that they saw the testatrix execute the same as and for her last will and testament whereof sound mind and that they know of no undue influence used or later will made before her decease to their knowledge or beliefs and that they subscribed the -----(cannot read)-----In testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal of the Registrar's office in Uniontown the same day and year above written.Robert Barton, Register Registered Sept. 12th, 1836.

Notes for ISAIAH RATCLIFF:

Isaiah was a blacksmith in Fayette Co. PA in the Redstone area. He was a Quaker or member of the Society of Friends. In one source, he is said to have died long before 1830. He is listed on an 1800 Census index as Esea Rackliff. His wife, Hannah, left a will in 1836 and he was then deceased. So he died sometime after 1803 and before 1810. The note also states he set up his blacksmith shop near Dunlaps Creek Church. Isaiah is named in his father's will in Bucks Co., Pennsylvania.
